## PEAK TO PEAK ANNUAL MEETING

## November 27, 2018

Rick called the meeting to order and asked for any additions or changes to the Agenda. There were none.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** The minutes from the September 27 board meeting were approved. She reported that there are 97 members. Forty-six members voted. Tom Knapp is keeping a spreadsheet of how often the pickleball courts are being used.

The plan is to remind players that they must pay \$3 or be a Silver Sneaker member to play. Every person playing must also sign in. There was also a discussion about renewing the county-required waiver and updating the Silver Sneakers membership.

**TOURNAMENTS:** There was a discussion about the wins at various pickleball tournaments around the state and US.

**CHRISTMAS PARTY:** Thursday, December 13, 5-9 pm. The entrée and fixings for a Taco Bar will be provided, with club members bringing side dishes. There will be a \$3 charge for costs and bartender.
